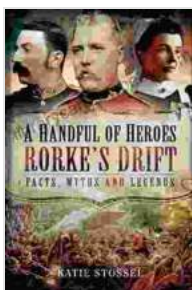

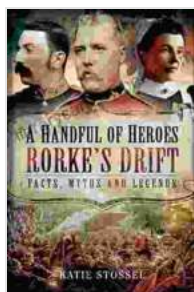
The Rorke's Drift Museum

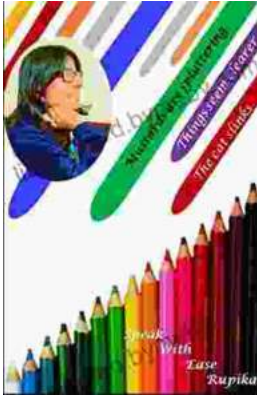

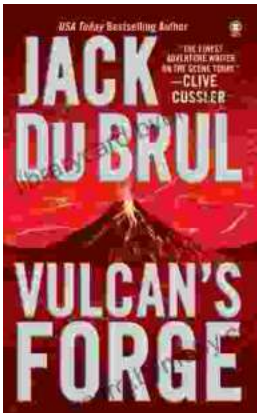
