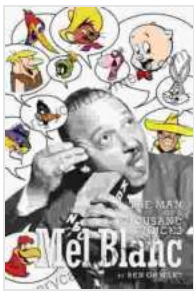


Mel Blanc: The Man of a Thousand Voices

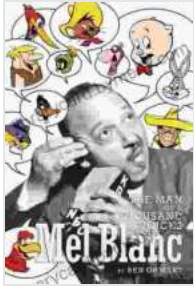
